# P.M. Meeting of 4-9-12

#### BUDGET COMMITTEE MEETING March 12, 2012 5:15 p.m.

PRESENT: Harry Sisk, Bill Armstrong, Tom Bowers, Nancy Brown, Steve Chambers, Scott Sams, Charlie Bayless and Lawrence Hodge.

Harry Sisk called the meeting to order.

Motion by Steve Chambers  $2^{nd}$  by Tom Bowers to adopt the agenda. All ayes, motion carried.

Motion by Bill Armstrong 2<sup>nd</sup> by Tom Bowers to approve the minutes of January 9, 2012 Budget meeting. All ayes, motion carried.

Matt Bailey-Chairman of 911 reported the Tennessee Emergency Communications Board has declared the Carter County 911 financially "at risk" due to funds that were cut in the 2005-06 budget. TECB has the authority to reduce the rates received by local 911 Districts for telephone landline surcharges if the 911 Districts are not properly funded by local governments. The opinion basically states that the imposition of the rate increase, when authorized, followed by a reduction of the funding from the local government, results in the effectual "back door tax", as the rate increase inures to the benefit of the local government. A request to reinstate the funds for the years since 2006 at the total of \$24,228.00 will ensure there is no loss of funding from the state.

Motion by Bill Armstrong 2<sup>nd</sup> by Scott Sams to fund \$24,228.00 from the fund balance to cover the short fall in the 911 budget and ensure funding for Carter County 911 District, voice roll call:

Mayor Humphrey requested the pay for the coroner be set at \$75.00 from \$50.00 per call due to the cost of gasoline and the number of calls he has. The Mayor has spoken with ETSU and everyone speaks about what a good job he has done. He stated that he feels this is the least we can do.

Tom Bowers-I agree he does a good job, but I feel this should be presented in the budget workshop.

Motion by Tom Bowers 2<sup>nd</sup> by Steve Chambers to table this until the 2012-13 budget workshop. 6 ayes, 2 no's, motion carried.

Tom Anderson spoke about the Snap-On tools Fast Track Grant. He stated the funds needed from the county would not exceed is \$17,440.00 to cover cost of setting a new transformer, move electric poles and water lines, and move dirt. Snap-On will be hiring 77 new employees.

Motion by Nancy Brown 2<sup>nd</sup> by Charlie Bayless to fund \$17,440.00 from fund balance for the Snap-On Tools Fast Track Grant.
